## Eligibility

Both junior representatives from diving clubs and national teams from all over the world are eligible for participation.

Independent and unattached divers cannot be eligible for the competition.

## Competition Format

All the events will follow the respective World Aquatics competition formats and will be held as direct finals, for both boys and girls. Please refer to the World Aquatics Diving Rules 2022-2025 rulebook (DAG 3.1 to 3.3) for the required dives for each event.

**AGE GROUP A (DAG 3.1):** 1m springboard, 3m springboard, platform

**AGE GROUP B (DAG 3.2):** 1m springboard, 3m springboard, platform

**AGE GROUP C (DAG 3.3):** 1m springboard, 3m springboard, platform

**AGE GROUP A/B/C (DAG 3.1):** 3m synchro springboard

## Age Groups

**AGE GROUP A** (girls / boys): 2007 – 2008 – 2009 (age 16 – 17 – 18)

**AGE GROUP B** (girls / boys): 2010 – 2011 (age 14 – 15)

**AGE GROUP C** (girls / boys): 2012 – 2013 (age 12 – 13)

Athletes may choose to take part in events for their Age Group or the upper one, if desired and if they have the required dive lists.

Athletes in the **Age Group D** (2014 – 2015) may take part to the Age Group C events if they have the required dive lists; in the platform event, Age Group D divers are strictly restricted to the 5m platform.

<b>Training</b>	<p>The facilities will be available for training from <b>June 4</b>, according to the schedule that will be provided some weeks before the event.</p> <p>On competition days, training is allowed at least 60 minutes before each session. Training between events may be restricted to the divers registered for the following events.</p>
<b>Technical Meeting</b>	<p>A technical meeting for the coaches will be held in the meeting room inside the venue on <b>June 5</b>.</p> <p>Judges' clinic will follow at the end of the meeting.</p>
<b>First Aid and Lifeguards</b>	<p>A safety rehearsal by expert lifeguards will take place at the venue on June 5. Lifeguards will be available during both training and competitions sessions.</p> <p>An emergency doctor will be available next to the secretary room during the competition.</p>
<b>Results</b>	<p>Results will be posted by the competition office after each event. Coverage of the event will be available through the official website <a href="http://www.romajuniordivingcup.it">www.romajuniordivingcup.it</a> and social network accounts associated to <b>M.R. Sport dei fratelli Marconi ASD</b> diving club (<a href="https://www.facebook.com/tuffimrsport">@tuffimrsport</a> on Facebook and Instagram).</p>
<b>Awards</b>	<p>Victory ceremonies will be held at the end of each event.</p> <p>Medals and special prizes by our sponsors will be presented to the first-, second- and third-placed divers of each event.</p>
<b>VISAs and Entry requirements</b>	<p>In order to avoid administrative issues when requesting a Visa, please contact the Italian Embassies or Consular Authorities within your country in due time before your planned departure.</p>

## Accommodation rates

Accommodation for all teams must be booked through the Organizing Committee.

***The Holy See holds its quarterly Jubilee (Holy Year) in 2025: over 100 million pilgrims are expected in Rome throughout the year, meaning the costs for accommodations will likely be significantly higher if you don't book through the Organizing Committee.***

Affiliated rates include:

- accommodation in three-star hotel in single, double or (if available) triple rooms;
- full board service;
- private shuttle to/from the venue at established times.

## Arrival / Departure

The Organizing Committee offers private transportation to/from Rome-Fiumicino Airport "Leonardo da Vinci" (FCO) and Rome Ciampino Airport "G.B. Pastine" (CIA), and/or Roma Termini/Roma Tiburtina train stations.

Affiliated transportation fare to/from the arrival airport/train station for the participating delegations, for up to four people and their luggage, is € 45,00 (one-way).

## Meals

Lunch will be prepared by a catering service and served fresh at the competition venue; specific details will be provided at the technical meeting. Breakfast and dinner will be served at the hotel.

Please keep in contact with the Organizing Committee for your special needs (i.e., food intolerances, allergies or particular diets).



## Dive Lists

Dive lists for each athlete and event will be handled through the DiveRecorder software ([www.diverecorder.co.uk](http://www.diverecorder.co.uk)). Dive lists may be updated up to 24 hours before the competition day.

Dive sheets shall be signed by a coach or a representative of the delegation on the day before the event (no later than 6pm).

A fee may be requested for last minute edits or error fixes.

## Registration Fees

A **Liquidation Form** for the athletes' registration fees, with all the banking informations, will be provided after the submission of the **Preliminary Entry Form**. Registration fees shall be paid – by wire transfer only – by April 20, 2025.

Registration fees for injured / no show athletes cannot be refunded.

Registration fees for divers added in the **Final Entry Form** shall be paid accordingly.

## Terms and Conditions / Personal Data used under the GDPR

By submitting the official forms, you agree and consent:

- a) to the provided personal data being processed, collected, used and/or retained by the organizing committee, its members and representatives for any competition purposes;
- b) to any media depicting the participating athletes and staff members to be displayed, collected, used and/or retained by the organizing committee, its members and representatives, the official websites and social networks and any authorized media operators for promotional purposes.

## Competition Schedule

A preliminary competition schedule will be released in late Winter.

Please note that the diving schedule may be changed at the discretion of the referee judge and/or the organizing committee.

Whenever in any event there would be five or fewer registered divers, the organizing committee may join the boys' and girls' events for that age group.

Whenever in any springboard event there would be a high number of registered divers, the organizing committee may carry out the two springboard events in the allotted session at the same time.

A proper warm-up time is guaranteed before each event, guaranteed at least for the registered athletes for that event.
